PT. 1 | THE JOURNEY TO HEALING

+ LENT IS A JOURNEY TOWARDS HEALING.

"He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life." 1 John 5:12

PT. 3 | HONESTY

PT. 4 | REPENTANCE

KEY VERSE

"And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart." Jeremiah 29:13

+ Repentance is a change of MIND

This man is a **Jew** in John 4:9

He is a **prophet** in John 4:19

He is the Messiah in John 4:25-26

KEY POINT Change of Mind happens in the presence of God

+ Repentance is a change of BEHAVIOR

"Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance." Matthew 3:8

+ Repentance then becomes a LIFESTYLE

"For Godly sorrow **produces repentance** leading to salvation" 2 Corinthians 7:10

Remember this about repentance...

- Whatever God does He does out of love
- Best time to respond is at the moment of conviction
- + God never asks anything of us without providing the grace to do it.

And He said to me, "**My grace** is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." 2 Corinthians 12:9

HEALING HUR+S

PT. 5 | GRACE

"God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work."

2 Corinthians 9:8

+ Grace is the power of God in our lives.

"And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world...and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." Ephesians 2:1-9

Grace is NOT giving us what we deserve, and then giving us what we could NEVER earn.

"But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more." Romans 5:20

"Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you." The man departed and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had made him well. For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath." John 5:14-16

"God never reveals a sickness that He isn't ready to heal by grace."

HOW DOES GRACE WORK?

+ God's grace is UNDESERVED, but it is not UNCONDITIONAL.

"A man by himself working and toiling at freedom from sinful desires achieves nothing. But if he plainly shows himself to be very eager and earnest about this, he attains it by the addition of the power of God. God works together with willing souls. But if the person abandons his eagerness, the spirit from God is also restrained. To save the unwilling is the act of one using compulsion; but to save the willing, that of one showing grace." St. Clement of Alexandria, 190 AD

"Human effort is profitless...without help from above, but no one receives such help unless he himself chooses to make an effort. We need always both things, we need the human and the divine, ascetic practice and spiritual knowledge..." St. Peter of Damascus, 750 AD

"Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us." Ephesians 3:20

"Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong." 2 Corinthians 12:8-10

HEALING HUR+S

PT. 6 | OBEDIENCE

"Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth. And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind? Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him. I must work the works of Him who sent Me...When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" ...So he went and washed, and came back seeing. Therefore, the neighbors and those who previously had seen that he was blind said, "Is not this he who sat and begged?" ...He said, "I am he." Therefore, they said to him, "How were your eyes opened?" He answered and said, "A Man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed, and I received sight." John 9:1-11

"But observe the mind of the blind man, obedient in everything. He did not say, "If it is really the clay or the spit which gives me eyes, what need is there of Siloam? Or if there is need of Siloam, what is the need of the clay?... But he entertained no such thoughts, he held himself prepared for one thing only, to obey in all things Him who gave the command..."
